



**\*\*Serenity is slow to felt. Be prepared to felt for at least 20 minutes.  
The effect is worth the time it takes to felt.\*\***

**Materials:** Kollage Yarns, 1 - 150 yard hank Serenity, # 13 needles

## CLUTCH

**Gauge:** 4 sts = 1" in Stockinette Stitch

### Purse:

Cast on 42 sts. Work in Stockinette stitch for 10 rows.

### Shape handle:

Row 1 - K10 -- Cast off 22 -- K 10  
Row 2 - K 10 -- Cast on 22 -- K10  
Work even in St st, until piece measures 17".

### Shape handle:

Row 1 - K 10 -- Cast off 22 -- K10  
Row 2 - K 10 -- Cast on 22 -- K 10  
Work 10 rows. Cast off.

### Finishing:

Seam sides.  
Felt and block.  
Place 10 Accentable's randomly along front of bag and sew in place.



## ENVELOPE BAG

**Gauge:** 4 sts = 1" in Stockinette Stitch.

### Strap:

Cast on 3 sts. Knit a 36" I cord. Set aside  
Cast off

### Purse:

Cast on 2 sts. Inc 1 st each edge at the beginning of each row to 40 sts. Knit even to desired length or until almost all yarn is gone leaving just enough to seam the side.

### Finishing:

Seam Sides of bag up to flap. Sew I cord strap to each bag side. Felt and block.
