100% corn, color Antique Lace

Hot Cotton Version:

Yarn and Needles
150 yards of worsted weight yarn
Size US 10 (5 mm) needles suggested
Gauge: 3.5 stitches per inch over stockinette stitch

Sizing

Planned for finished measurements of 6" wide x 48" long

Scarf Instructions
Cast on 22 sts loosely.

Work Pattern Stitch until length desired and completing row 18.

Cornucopia Version:

Yarn and Needles
200 yards of worsted weight yarn
Size US 8 (5 mm) needles suggested
Gauge: 4 stitches per inch over stockinette stitch

Sizing

Planned for finished measurements of 5" wide x 41" long

Scarf Instructions
Cast on 32 sts loosely.

Work Pattern Stitch until length desired and completing row 18.

p2 tog-b Purl 2 together through the back loop.

Will need additional yarn if you wish to add fringe.

Pattern Stitch

Row 1: K1, * yo, k8, k2 tog; rep from *, end k1. (right side)
Row 2: P1, * p2 tog, p7, yo, p1; rep from *, end p1.
Row 3: K1, * k2, yo, k6, k2 tog; rep from *, end k1.
Row 4: P1, * p2 tog, p5, yo, p3; rep from *, end p1.
Row 5: K1, * k4, yo, k4, k2 tog; from *, end k1.
Row 6: P1, * P2 tog, P3, yo, P5; rep from *, end p1.
Row 7: K1, * k6, yo, k2, k2 tog; from *, end k1.
Row 8: P1, * p2 tog, p1, yo, p7; rep from *, end p1.
Row 9: K1, * k8, yo, k2 tog; from *, end k1.
Row 10: P1, * yo, p8, p2 tog-b; rep from *, end p1.
Row 11: K1, * ssk, k7, yo, k1; from *, end k1.
Row 12: P1, * p2, yo, p6, p2 tog-b; rep from *, end p1.
Row 13: K1, * ssk, k5, yo, k3; from *, end k1.
Row 14: P1, * p4, yo, p4, p2 tog-b; rep from *, end p1.
Row 15: K1, * ssk, k3, yo, k5; from *, end k1.
Row 16: P1, * p6, yo, p2, p2 tog-b; rep from *, end p1.
Row 17: K1, * ssk, k1, yo, k7; from *, end k1.
Row 18: P1, * p8, yo, p2 tog-b; rep from *, end p1.

Finishing

Weave in yarn ends invisibly.

Hand wash in cool water or according to your yarn's card instructions. Lay flat to dry, finger blocking with light tension to preserve stitch pattern texture. If your yarn is machine dryable, you may instead dry as instructed until barely damp and complete the drying by laying flat and neatening the shape with a light finger blocking.
